## **RUBRIC**

A 4 point essay demonstrates a high *degree of competence* in response to the assignment but may have a few minor errors.

An essay in this category demonstrates his/her/their position clearly, and:

- Consistently organizes and develops ideas logically, making insightful connections between them.
- Clearly explains key ideas, supporting them with well-chosen reasons, examples, or details.
- Displays effective sentence variety.
- Uses professional language which demonstrates knowledge of the field. 0
- Is written without errors in grammar, usage, and mechanics.
- A 3 point essay demonstrates *competence* in response to the assignment.

An essay in this category:

- 0 States or implies the writer's position or thesis
- 0 Shows adequate control in the organization and development of ideas
- Explains clearly 2 of 3 key ideas, supporting them with adequate reasons examples or details.
- Displays adequate use of language. 0
- Displays minor errors in grammar, usage, and mechanics. 0
- A 2 point essay demonstrates some competence in response to the assignment but is obviously flawed. An essay in this category reveals one or more of the following weaknesses:
  - Limited in stating or implying a position or thesis.
  - Presents some control in the organization and development of ideas.
  - 0 Explains 1 of 3 key ideas, supporting them with adequate reasons examples or details.
  - 0 Inadequate reasons, examples, or details to explain key ideas.
  - Consistent errors in the use of language, grammar, usage, and mechanics. 0

### A 1 point essay is seriously flawed.

An essay in this category reveals *one or more* of the following weaknesses:

- The essay does not reflect professional thinking or writing.
- Not evidence of organization or very little development.
- No key ideas demonstrated.
- Lack of relevant reasons, examples, or details.
