

Scorpion Academic Scholarship

Maintaining Scholarship Eligibility

Students must be enrolled full-time, 12 or more financial aid-eligible credits, at Nevada State College to receive the award during a semester.

Nevada State College will confirm enrollment after the end of each semester's add/drop period, and reverse any disbursements for which a student is no longer eligible based on decreased enrollment.

Students placed on Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) suspension are ineligible to receive an award until they regain good SAP standing, which requires a minimum 2.0 cumulative NSC GPA and 67% pace of credit completion. The full SAP policy [is available here](#).

In the event recipients do not meet the enrollment or SAP requirements for any award in a semester, they may regain eligibility in the next fall or spring semester until their award expires, by enrolling full-time or regaining good SAP standing.

In order to qualify for any financial aid funding, including grants, scholarships or loans, a course must fulfill an unmet requirement for a student's degree or certificate program at NSC.

Students in their final semester of enrollment who are not required to attend full-time to satisfy graduation requirements may have their award prorated according to their enrollment level. 75 percent for $\frac{3}{4}$ time, 50 percent for $\frac{1}{2}$ time and 25 percent for less-than-half-time.
