If you have exceeded the 150% limit, you must meet with an Academic Advisor and you must include with this appeal a signed Academic Plan for the remainder of your program. In your appeal statement, you must indicate if you have changed degree programs, are pursuing a dual major or minor, second degree or post-baccalaureate coursework, or any other exceptional circumstances that should be considered.

STEP 3: Submit your signed appeal form, statement, and documents to NSC Financial Aid by the deadline.

- Submit your complete appeal no later than the first day of the semester. The deadline for summer is May 31.
- Incomplete petitions lacking documentation specified in Step 2 will not be considered.
- You will receive a response to your student email address within 14 calendar days.
